Explanation:

Your assignment is to keep a journal as if you were alive during World War II. Write at least one paragraph about each of the following events as your character would have perceived them.

Rules:

- Your journal must stay with the perspective of your character. Naturally, he/she would be an eyewitness to some events and only hear about others on the radio. Therefore, the length of writing for each topic will vary.
- You have to finish it. If your character dies, you must either choose another character or write from the perspective of your original character's ghost.
- You may not skip events. Your character is as informed about world events as I expect you to be.
- Your character may witness atrocities, but may not participate in them.
