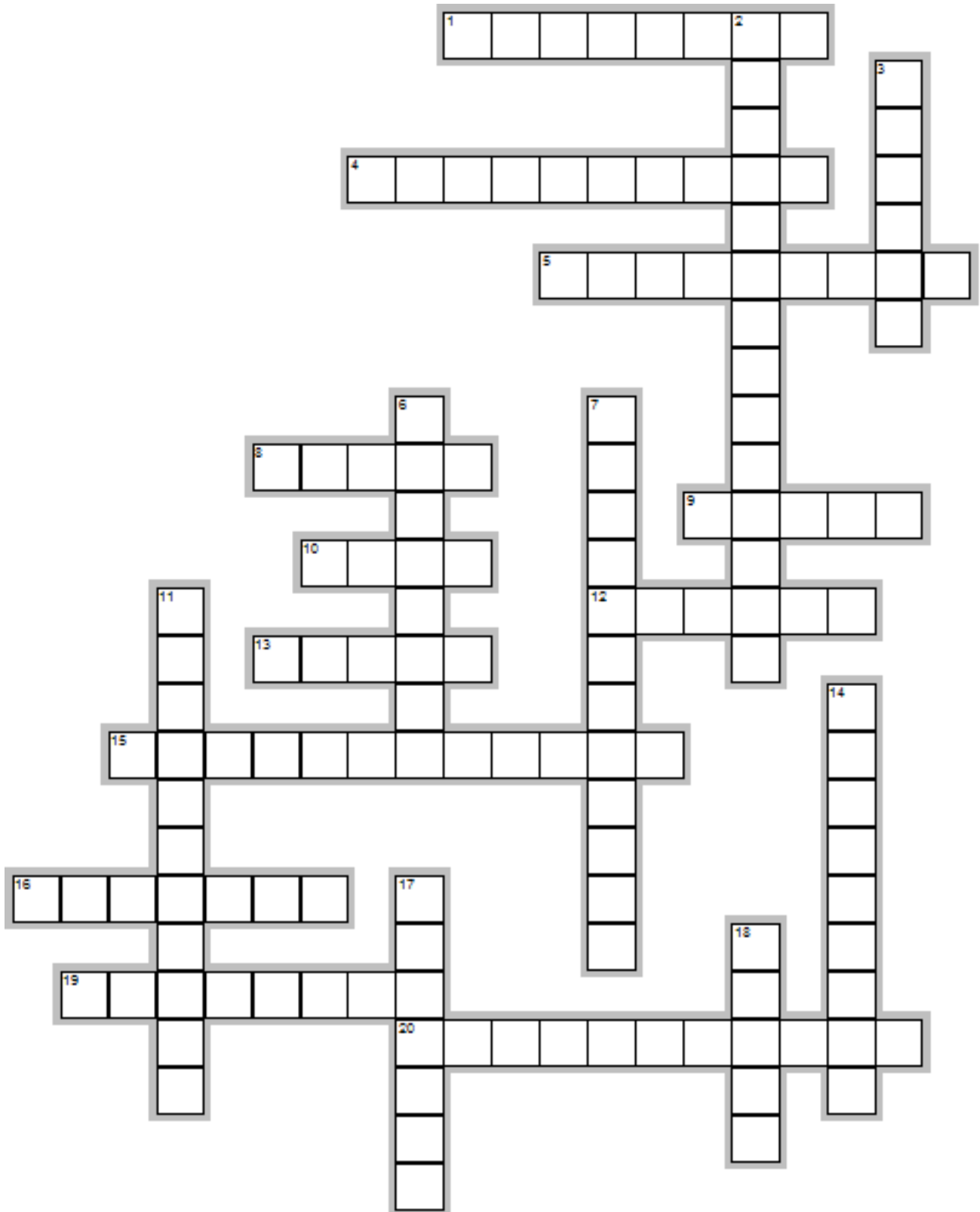

9. Known as "the Great." Ruler of Judea (Israel) under the Romans. Rebuilt the temple.
10. Greatest missionary for Christianity in the early church.

13. When the Senate refused to give him power, he marched on Rome and took control of the Senate with the military.
15. Roman general who was elected Dictator for Life. Overthrew the First Triumvirate and was ultimately killed by the Senate.
16. A river in ancient Rome. Caesar's crossing this river amounted to a declaration of war against Pompey.
19. The scattering of the Jewish people by the Roman empire.
20. Roman emperor who set up two capitals for the Roman empire. Also the first to begin the acceptance of Christianity.
